UNIT 1 WORSHIP

Unit Introduction:

Worship means to praise and exalt God. God created man to worship Him. In Luke 19:40 Jesus said that if no man praised God, the stones would cry out in praise to their creator.

Members of the first church worshiped God. They sang, rejoiced and prayed. They also gave all their possessions to the church. In this **Champion Blue Rank Manual** you will learn how the people in God's churches worship God today by:



Prerequisite To Worship:

A prerequisite is something you must do before you can do something else. A prerequisite for worship is repentance. Repentance means to confess your sins and be truly sorry.

We must repent to accept Jesus' gift of salvation. The **ABC**'s of salvation are

Admit you are a sinner.

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23).

Believe Jesus died for you.

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8).

Confess Jesus as your Savior.

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Rom. 10:9).



Memorize this verse.

"I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance."

Luke 15:7

As there is joy and celebration in Heaven over one person who is saved, we, too, should be happy when someone accepts Jesus Christ as his personal Savior.

God's gift of salvation is always a reason to worship Him.

Church Attendance and Giving Project

Omnipotent

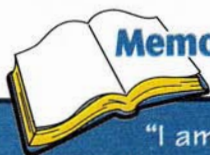
being present in all places at all times
