

SECTION I

CREATION

The first act or deed of God to show His power was in creation. Many things have been created, and God made them all. There is an old English hymn that tells of God's power.

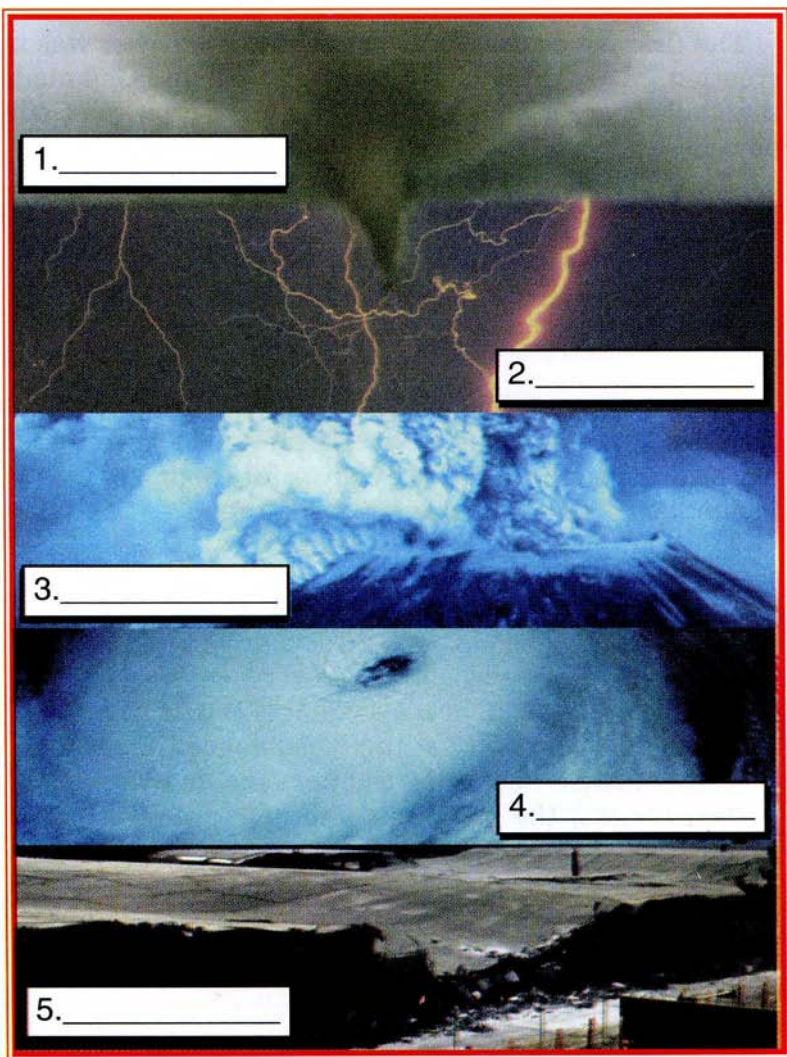
