EVERYTHING I NEED

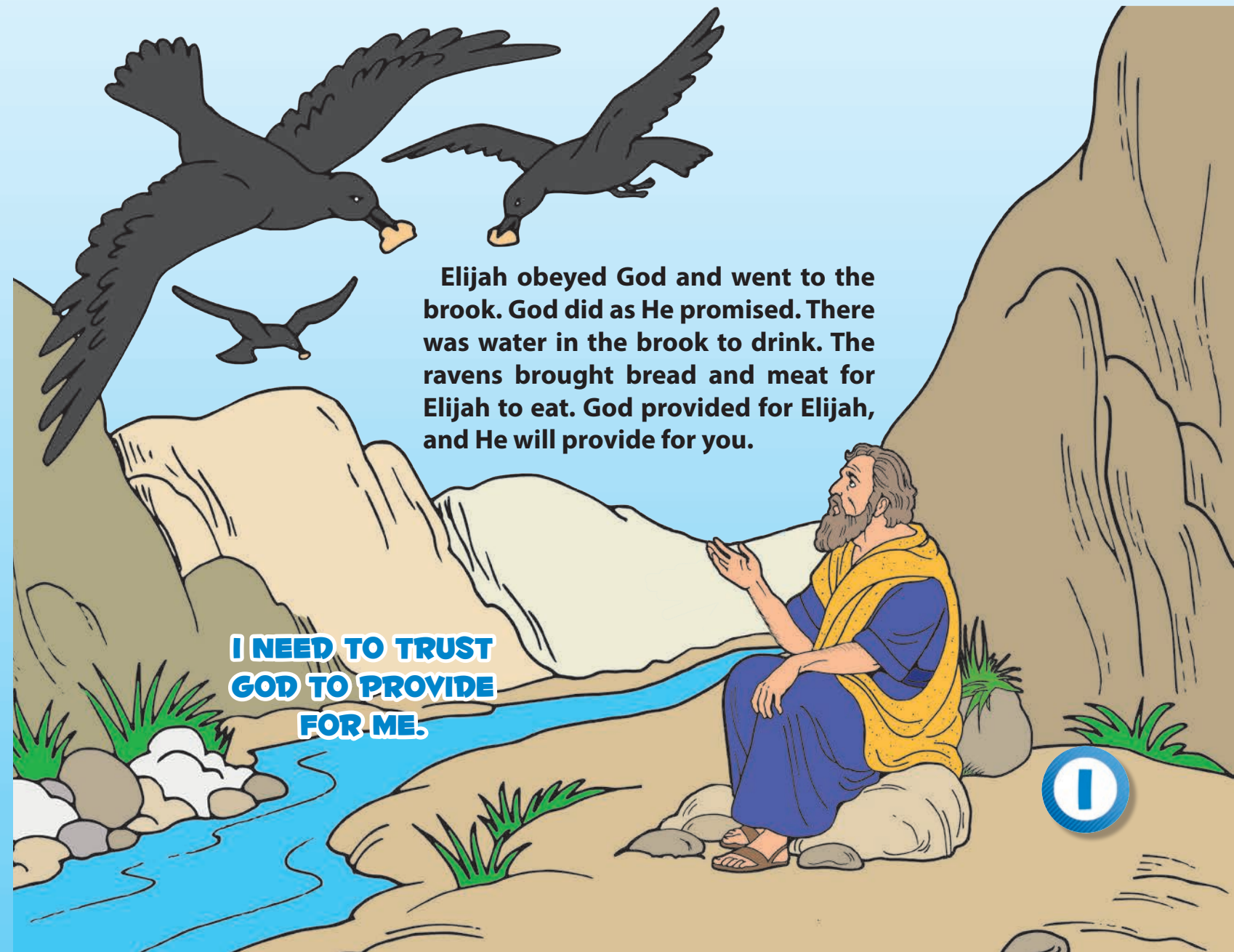
1 Kings 17:1-6

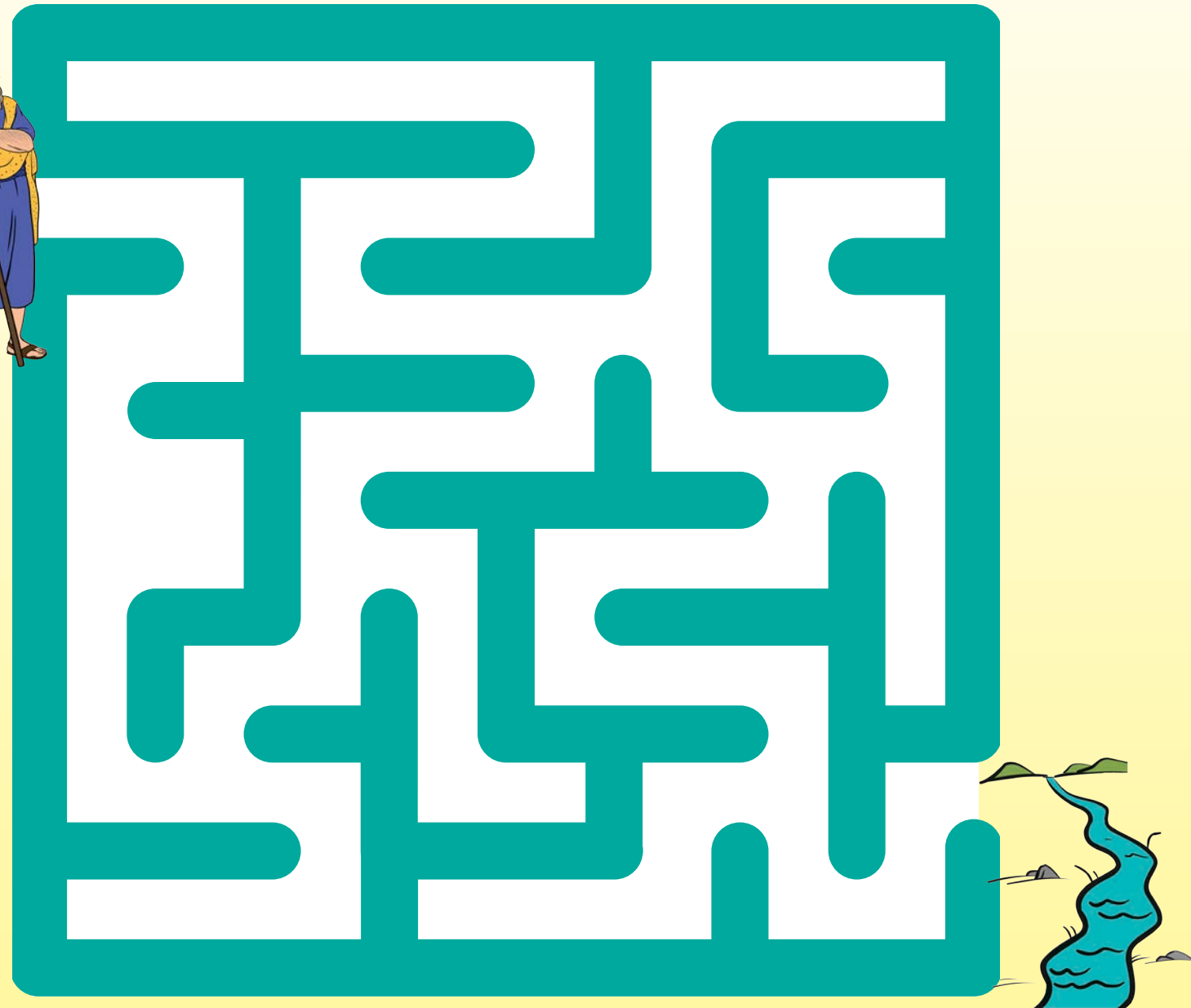

Help Elijah find his way to the Brook Cherith. Trace the path with your finger. Then trace the path with a marker or crayon.

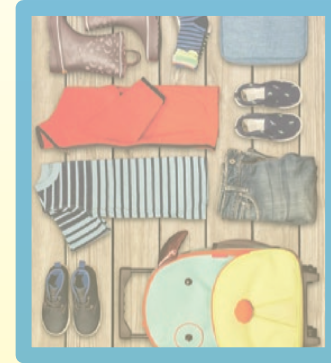
