

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Share the good news of Jesus with people you meet this week. Ask for an adult family member's help in giving out either the tracts you received from your Sunday School teacher or ones that you design. On a small piece of paper draw a picture that represents the good news of Jesus. Write some Bible verses about salvation on your tract. Be sure to include an invitation to attend worship services and Sunday School. Write your church name and address on the back of the tracts so that those you invite will be able to find directions.

**3RD & 4TH GRADE**

Gather your family members or a group of friends and play a game of memory verse Hide-and-seek like you did with your classmates during Sunday School. Share with them all you learned about Jonah trying to hide from God. Begin by teaching your family and friends the Lesson 10 memory verse from side 1. Choose someone to count while everyone else hides. When the person is finished counting, he should go seek those who are hiding. Those who are found must recite the memory verse. The first person to say it correctly becomes the next one to be *It*.

**3RD & 4TH GRADE**

Since both the Unit 2 and Lesson 9 memory verses are the same, create a memory verse poster to put on the refrigerator. This poster will help you remember to practice the memory verse. Be creative in your design of the poster. Consider using pictures for some of the words. For example, draw a hand instead of writing the word hand. Think about someone you know who needs to be saved. Make him a poster, too, and give it to him.

Draw pictures of your friends. When your pictures are complete, look at each of your friends on the page and answer the following question: Does he know Jesus as his personal Savior? You may not know the answer, but this week would be a good time to find out. Being a godly friend begins with sharing Jesus with others. Ask your friends if they are saved. If they are not, tell them about Jesus and salvation. Tell them that Jesus is the best friend they can have. Be a godly friend by telling your friends about the greatest friend there is—Jesus!
