

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In the lesson today, Malachi rebuked the priests for their feeble attempts at worship. We need to make sure that we give our best to God. Think of an area where you have not been giving God your best. Is it your thoughts? your time? your talents? your treasure? Once you know where you need to improve, make a plan to do it. Ask your pastor or Sunday School teacher for help.

God loves you even when you don't show Him love. Is there someone whom you need to show His love to this week? This person may even be someone who is unkind or unloving to you. How can you show him the love of Jesus? Brainstorm on ways to do this and then do it! By showing love to others even when they are unkind, you are being like Jesus and that makes Him proud of you.

Plan a special meal, a nature walk or any other activity to celebrate God and His goodness to you. Ask your parents if you can invite someone to your Thanksgiving celebration. Read Scriptures and have a special time of prayer just praising God.

Color me!

It is a good idea to take these cards with you wherever you go. You may want to punch holes in cards and tie together with string or ribbon, or you could keep the cards on a carabiner.

However you choose to carry them, remember to share their messages with friends and family whenever you can!

Although Jesus' resurrection is described differently in the gospels, the main elements are the same—Jesus rose again on the third day and was seen by many. Here are Scriptures from John that give the order of events leading to the resurrection. Share Jesus' death, burial and resurrection with someone this week. Who can you share with?

John 18:2—Judas betrayed Jesus.  
John 18: 31-40—Jesus was questioned by Pilate.  
John 19:1, 2—Jesus was scourged and received a crown of thorns.  
John 19:18—Jesus was crucified.  
John 19:38-42—Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus wrapped the body in linen and placed it in a tomb.  
John 20:12—Angels sat where Jesus' body had been located; the linen grave clothes remained.  
John 20:15—Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene.  
John 20:19-31—Jesus appeared to the disciples and many others; Thomas learned that people are blessed when they believe without seeing.

This week, we learned that God is in control of time and events. He is in control even when we are not. He is in control even when bad things happen. He has a plan. His plan is excellent. He is working all things together for your good and for His glory. This week, when you are tempted to fear, worry or stress—don't! Instead, pray and trust that God is in control.
