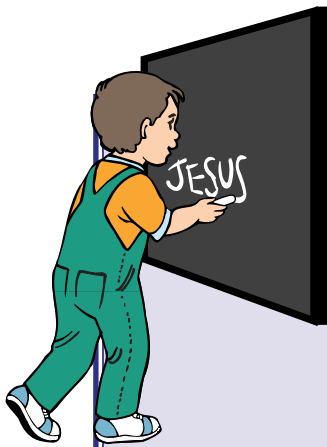



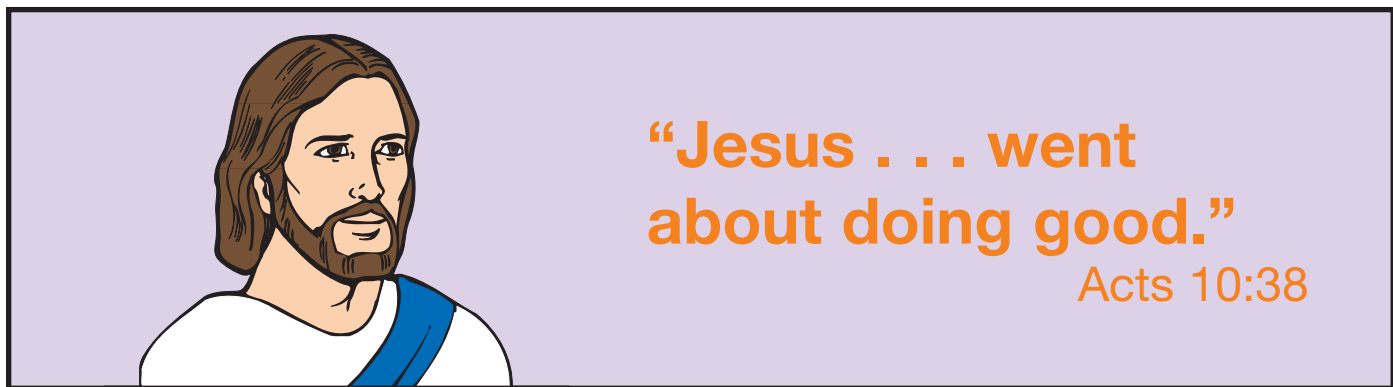

Jesus Makes Sick People Well

Matthew 8:14-17; Mark 1:29-34; Luke 4:38-41

Jesus was a good friend. Jesus helped sick people. Peter's mother-in-law was very sick. She had a fever. Her head felt hot. She did not feel like sitting up. She lay in bed.

Jesus came to the house with Peter. Jesus walked to the bed where the woman lay sick. He took her by the hand. All at once the fever left. The woman felt good again. She got up from the bed.

The woman probably smiled. She probably said, "Thank You, Jesus, for making me well." Then she took care of them. Maybe she cooked a good meal.

Jesus healed many other sick people, too. "Jesus . . . went about doing good" (Acts 10:38). Jesus is God's Son. We can trust Jesus to help when we are sick.
