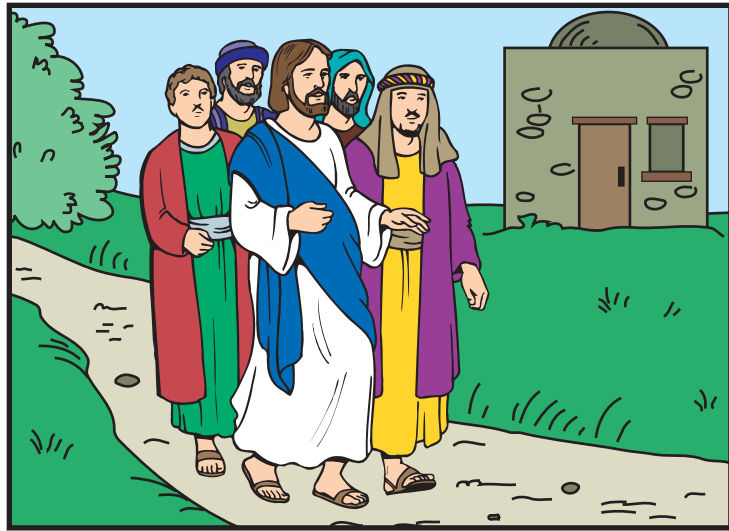
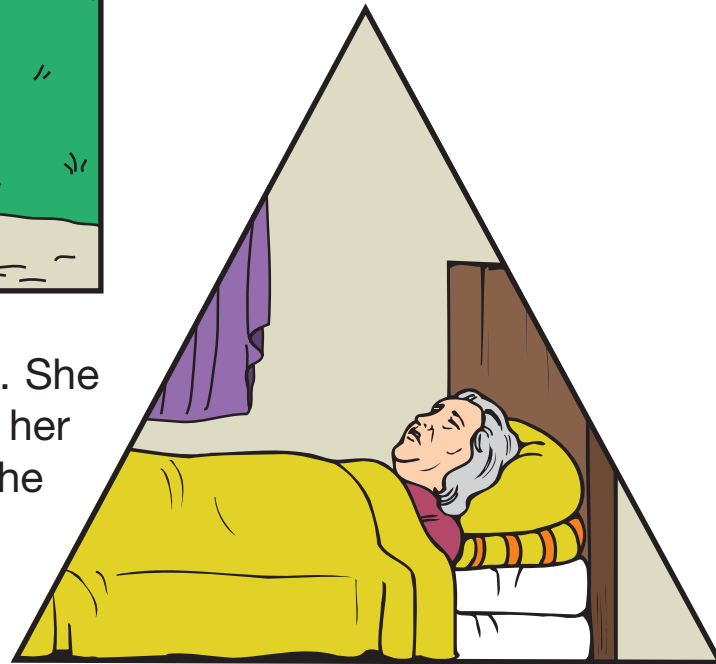


Jesus Makes Sick People Well

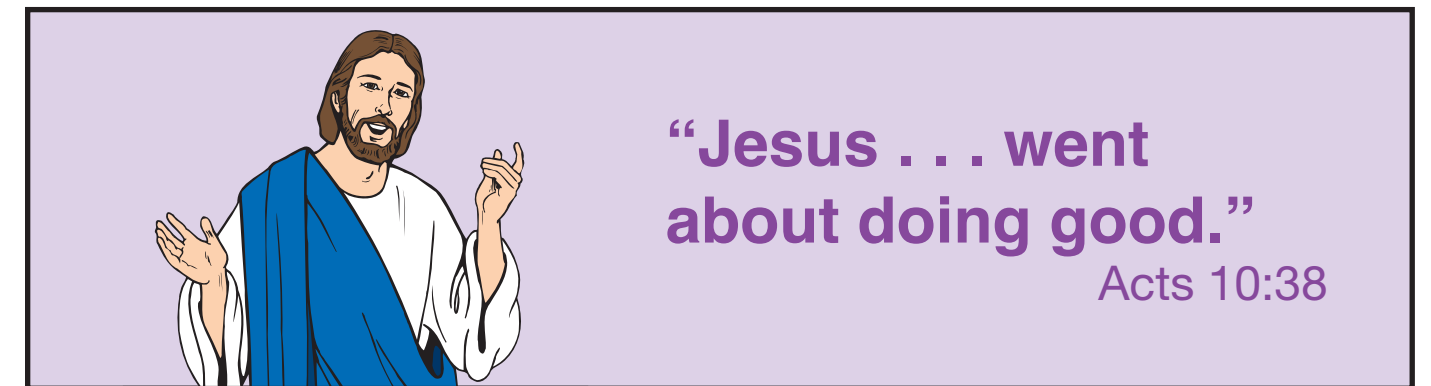
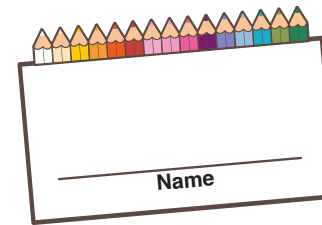
Then the sun set. People began coming to Peter's house. Many brought sick people with them. The whole city gathered at the door. Jesus healed sick bodies. He made people well again.
