

# BEGINNER MAKE AND TAKE INSTRUCTIONS

## **Lesson 1 - March 4, 2018**

Have learners address the letter to parents or guardian. Provide the stamp and seal from the sticker page. Ask learners to deliver the letter and discuss its contents with their parents or guardians.

## **Lesson 2 - March 11, 2018**

Help Me Remember Bookmark. Help learners cut out the bookmarks. If time is limited, cut bookmarks out prior to class. Have learners use stickers provided on the sticker page, red yarn and small bandage strips to decorate the bookmarks. The Rahab sticker and red yarn serve as a reminder of Lesson 2, while the sticker of the Samaritan and the small bandage strip help recall Lesson 1. Have them place the items on opposite sides. Fold on the broken line and glue together to create a bookmark. Review both lessons as learners work on the make and take project.

## **Lesson 3 - March 18, 2018**

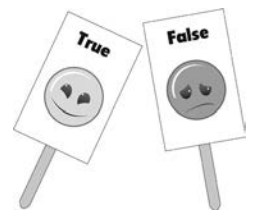
Have learners place the sticker from the sticker page on the designated area of the gift card. Remind them to sign the card and write a kindness they can give on the line provided. Encourage learners to share the gift with someone in their church, community or family. Make a note to discuss how some may have shared this gift before next week's lesson.

## **Lesson 4 - March 25, 2018**

Picture Matching Game. Cut the picture cards apart before class or have learners color and cut them apart. Play the matching game described in the teacher's guide under the Make and Take section.

## **Lesson 5 - April 1, 2018**

True or False Activity. Cut out the answer cards. (Do not cut in half.) Have learners fold along dotted lines and place stickers from the sticker page on the proper sides of the project (smile on the true side, frown on the false side). Staple or tape the cards together around a craft stick to form paper Popsicles. Have class members turn the project to reflect the correct answer to review questions. Save the craft for future review. Tell learners they may take the craft home at the end of the quarter.



## **Lesson 6 - April 8, 2018**

Clue Match. Place the stickers on the chart to match the clues under the spaces. Read the clues to the class or have members take turns reading the clues. Briefly talk about each story as the stickers are attached in order.

## **Lesson 7 - April 15, 2018**

Have learners place the books from the sticker page on the bookshelf to show if they are in the Old Testament or in the New Testament. Give them the hint that the books of the Bible are listed in the front of most of their Bibles. Using your Bible, turn to Genesis and briefly explain the division

of the Old and New Testaments. Turn to the Gospel of Matthew and briefly explain that the New Testament is written about Jesus and church activities. If time permits, have learners find Genesis and Matthew as you discuss the two testaments.

### **Lesson 8 - April 22, 2018**

Find the locations on the map for Lesson 8 and previous lessons. Distribute stickers from the sticker page. Have learners place stickers at the site of the lessons as they are reviewed.

### **Lesson 9 - April 29, 2018**

Sharing Cards and Treats. Provide treats to share along with the make and take cards as described in the Make and Take section of the teacher's guide. Tear out the project sheets and help learners create slogans that include the name or a characteristic of their treat. Encourage them to share the treats and cards with someone they love.

### **Lesson 10 - May 6, 2018**

Finger Puppets. Cut out the figures prior to class. If time permits, let class members color the project. Tape the puppets around the finger of learners and use as instructed in the teacher's guide under the Make and Take section.

### **Lesson 11 - May 13, 2018**

Have learners use the triangular stickers from the sticker page to show where the stories are found in the Bible.

### **Lesson 12 - May 20, 2018**

Slide Review. Have learners attach stickers from the sticker page to the circles on the sticker strips. Cut out all the strips. Glue the ends of the sticker strips together to make one strip. Cut slits in the slide strip. Demonstrate how to pull the sticker strip through the slits of the slide strip to present a slide presentation. Encourage learners to discuss the various characters and stories with friends, parents and other family members.

### **Lesson 13 - May 27, 2015**

A Surprise To Share. Have learners color the picture. Punch holes on the X's in the coloring picture. Distribute two small suckers to each class member. Have him insert the suckers into the punched holes. Encourage each child to keep one sucker and share the other with a friend.

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# Dear Parents

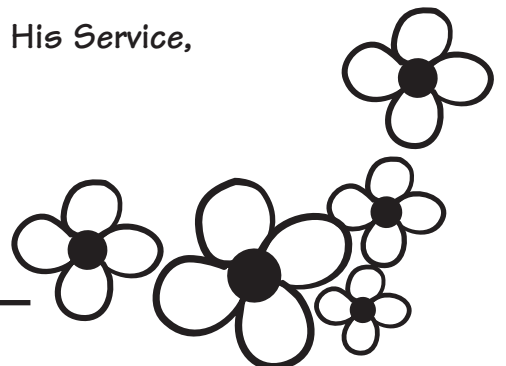

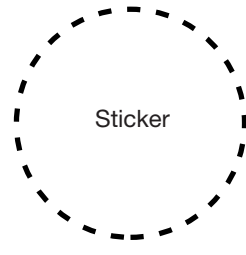
