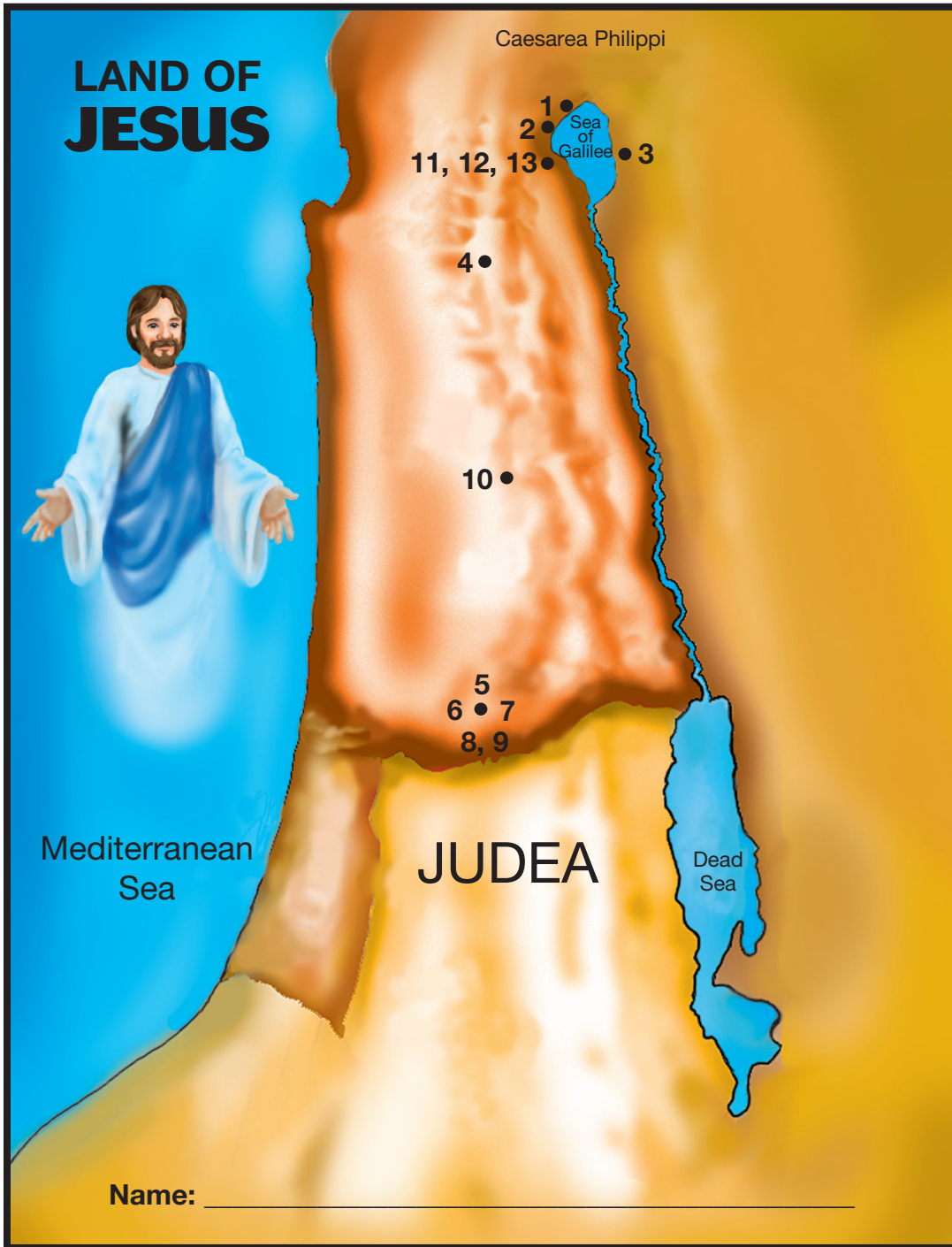

LESSON 1

Purpose of Miracles

Lesson Objective

I will know Jesus' miracles were to show He was the Son of God.

Bible Principle

The miracles of Jesus were intended to prove His deity.

Parallel Passage

Come from God
John 3:1, 2
Memory Verse:
"No man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him," John 3:2.

That Ye May Know

Matthew 9:2-8; Mark 2:1-12;
Luke 5:17-26

A man had palsy, a paralyzing disease. His four friends wanted to take Him to Jesus to be healed. They carried him on a bed-like pallet. They could not take the paralyzed man right to Jesus because a large crowd of people blocked the door. The four men carried the paralyzed man upon the roof of the house and lowered him in front of Jesus.

Jesus knew the paralyzed man needed to be healed and forgiven of his sins. Jesus said, "Thy sins be forgiven thee." The man believed what Jesus said. He got up, picked up his bed and walked away from Jesus with his body

completely healed. Jesus performed a miracle, an event that sets aside the usual laws of nature to accomplish a certain act.

Jesus also knew the thoughts of the four men who brought the paralyzed man to Him. Jesus demonstrated His love for all five men. He healed the man of his palsy and forgave his sins. He also demonstrated his love for the people in the crowd. The miracle of healing the paralyzed man showed them He had power to forgive their sins.

The people in the crowd reacted in different ways toward Jesus. Some did not understand how Jesus could heal a man who was paralyzed. Others recognized that Jesus was God because He healed the man. The scribes thought Jesus was a blasphemer, a person who curses God. They did not recognize His deity, the divine nature of God. They did not believe Jesus had the power to heal diseases and the right to forgive sins. Jesus charged them with thinking evil and having harmful motives in their hearts.

Confidence in Jesus is believing and trusting Him enough to put confidence into action. The four men had such confidence. They carried the man to Jesus. They did not give up when the door was blocked. They looked for a way to get the man to Jesus. The paralyzed man also believed in Jesus. He followed Jesus' instructions. He walked to his home carrying his bed.

You can have confidence in Jesus. You have to come to Jesus yourself and say, "I am a sinner. I believe You have the power to save me from my sins. I ask You to save me." At that instant Jesus will forgive your sins.

BIBLE MIRACLES

A miracle is an event that sets aside the usual laws of nature. A miracle is supernatural. This means a miracle cannot happen in a natural way. Miracles happen when God changes natural laws that govern our world. A miracle is an exception to the usual rule.

The Bible records about thirty-five miracles Jesus did while He was on earth. He must have done many more. John wrote that Jesus did “many other signs” which His disciples saw that he did not write in his book. John said he wrote about the signs so that you “might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name,” John 20:30, 31.

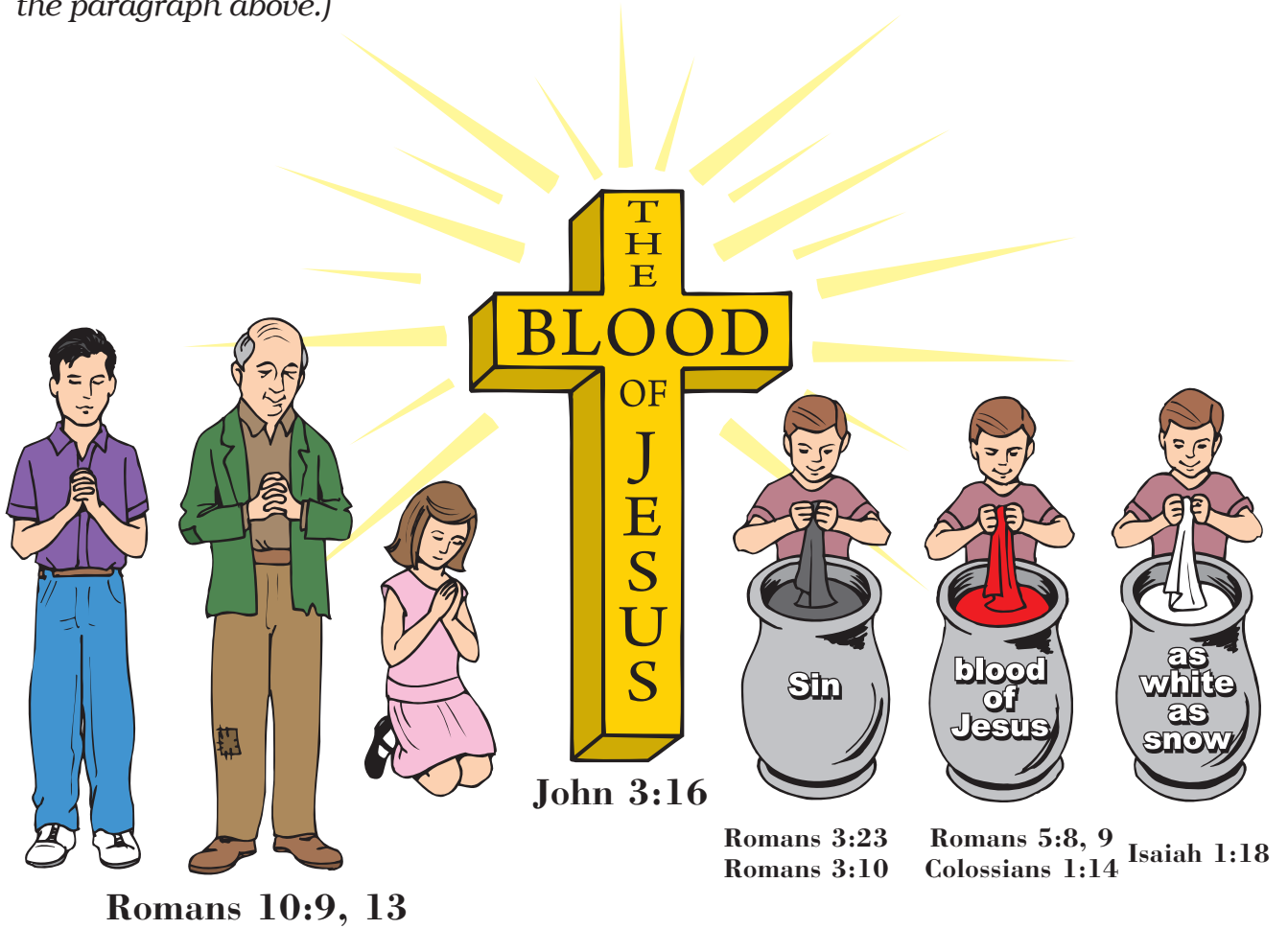
