MAKE AND TAKE INSTRUCTIONS

Winter Quarter, 2017-2018

Lesson 1 - December 3, 2017

The learner will address the letter to parents or a guardian and seal it with the sticker from the sticker page.

Lesson 2 - December 10, 2017

The learner will complete information about the church he attends. Fold the page to form an invitation and give it to a family member, friend or neighbor.

Lesson 3 - December 17, 2017

The learner will make a star ornament for his room. Fold the star for double thickness. Add the star and the wise men stickers from the sticker page. Punch a hole and tie yarn to the ornament to create a hanger.

Lesson 4 - December 24, 2017

The learner will place stickers of the Tabernacle, Temple and his church on the map at the appropriate places.

Lesson 5 - December 31, 2017

The learner will record his New Year's Resolutions. The project may be mounted on construction paper for display in the classroom.

Lesson 6 - January 7, 2018

The learner will color the picture of the two boys. Discuss wrong choices and bad habits which lead to messy rooms, loss of possessions and late arrivals. Discuss ways the boys can begin to choose between right and wrong.

Lesson 7 - January 14, 2018

The learner will cut out the heart and mount it on construction paper. Add the Key Verse stickers from the sticker page.

Lesson 8 - January 21, 2018

The learner will make a Concentration Game by cutting apart the cards. To play the game, lay the cards facedown in three rows of four to each row. A learner will turn over two cards. If they match, he removes those two cards and takes another turn. If they do not match, the cards are read and turned facedown for the next player. The learner with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.

Lesson 9 - January 28, 2018

The learner will make a prayer calendar. Stickers from the sticker page may be placed on the calendar in the order the learner chooses. The learner is to check the day of the week as he prays for the object of prayer for that day.

Lesson 10 - February 4, 2018

The learner will make a backpack to remind him of things that can be given to God. Attach the sticker to the middle section of the backpack, lining the letters up to form new words as the backpack is opened.

Lesson 11 - February 11, 2018

The learner will fold the page to make a church. Attach the Key Verse sticker from the sticker page.

Lesson 12 - February 18, 2018

The learner will glue a penny in the center of the make and take project circle. Attach the stickers of the Key Verse to decorate the circle. Cut out and mount the white circle on the large red paper circle and the red circle on a larger blue circle. Tie yarn to the circle through a hole to create a necklace or door hanger.

Lesson 13 - February 25, 2018

The learner will make a Key Verse stand. The project may be colored and completed with heart stickers from the sticker page.

Dear Parents,

For the next three months our class will study worship, prayer and giving. Since each term is abstract, your child will need help to grasp the meanings.

To help a child understand worship, parents can model through family devotions. A parent who reads and explains Bible verses helps his child understand that God's Word is the guide to true worship. It also leads him to realize that God alone deserves worship.

A regularly scheduled time for prayer in the home is essential for a stable Christian lifestyle. If your child has not memorized the Model Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13), help him put this prayer to memory during the next five or six weeks.

Cheerful giving of self and possessions is a source of lifelong joy. Children who see selfless giving within the family unit are destined for a richer life. God requires pure motives in service to Him. The motive for giving is more important than the amount given. Examples of gifts include appropriate toys to the church nursery or a portion of your child's allowance as a monetary offering. Talents, time and service are also offerings which can be given to God by sharing them with others.
