Examples of Worship, Prayer and Stewardship




Children learn more by personal involvement in the lesson. These lesson-related projects encourage personal involvement.


Here is a time-saving tip that will make you happy all quarter. Start with thirteen file folders and label them Lesson 1 through Lesson 13. Remove the covers from all make and take books.

Remove the sticker pages from the center of the books and place them in a file folder. Open a book to the center and use a paper cutter to cut half of the book's pages along the perforation line. Turn the book and cut the pages of the other half in the same way. Repeat this for all the books. Then, separate and stack the pages by lessons. File each lesson by number in the file folders.

Weekly preparation time is greatly reduced with this preparation. Simply pull the file for the lesson needed with the project pages then pull the folder with the sticker pages.



1. Cut around the outside lines of the stand-up folder. Fold forward on the broken lines.
2. Add the J, O, Y and Scripture stickers from the sticker page.
3. Set the worship reminder somewhere to help you remember to worship God throughout your day.



Cut on solid lines of the prayer reminder cube.

Fold on broken lines.

Glue sides together.

Add stickers concerning prayer from the sticker page.

Toss the cube in the air.

Read the word on the side facing up.

Make a sentence about prayer using that word.

Toss it again and repeat the instructions.

Play the game with a friend for more fun.

1. Color the pictures of the wise men's gifts.
2. Cut on the solid lines around the project. Cut on the solid line between each gift only to the broken lines.
3. Fold the top section down so that the picture is on top.
4. Under the tabs, write something about each gift the wise men gave to worship Jesus.
