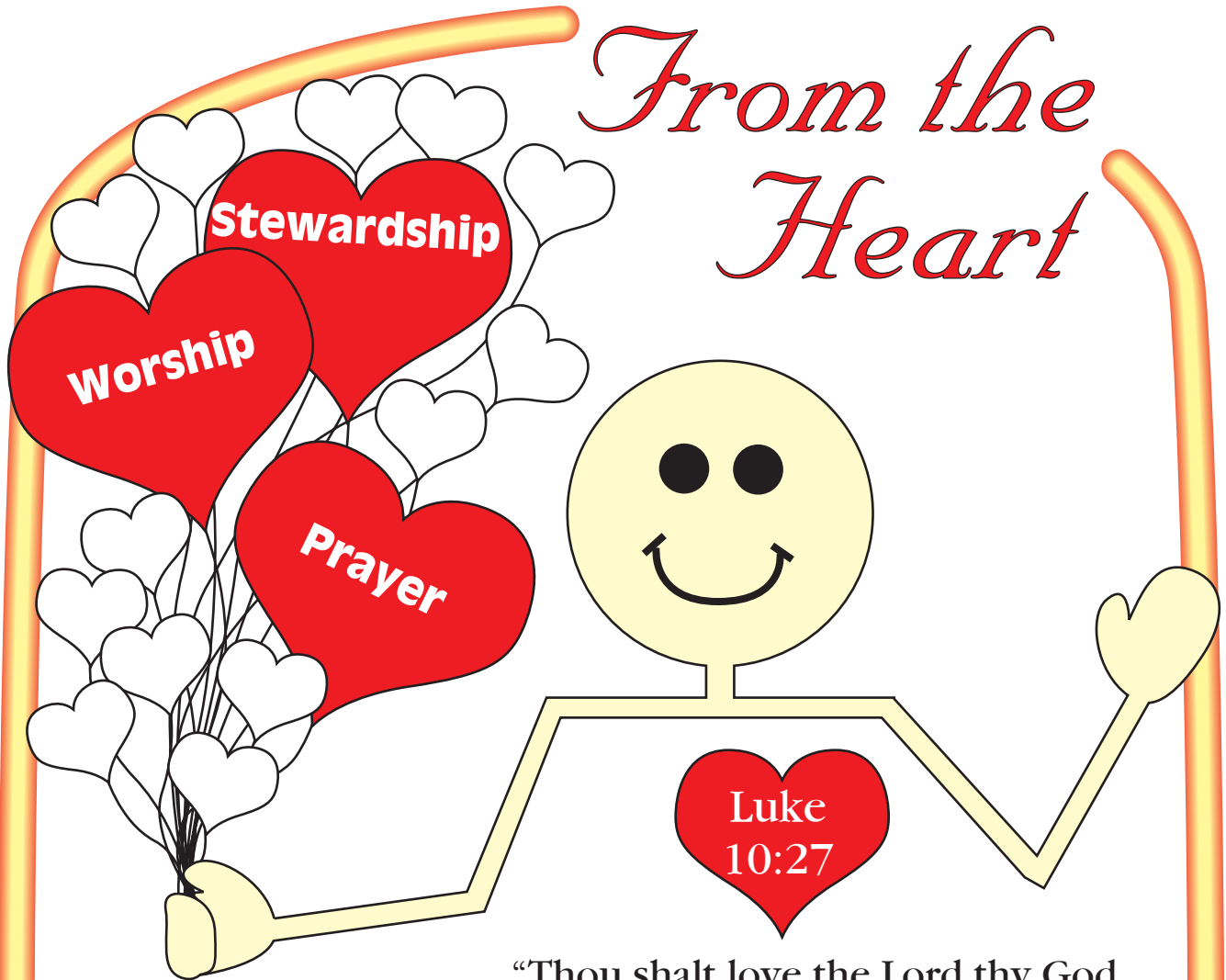

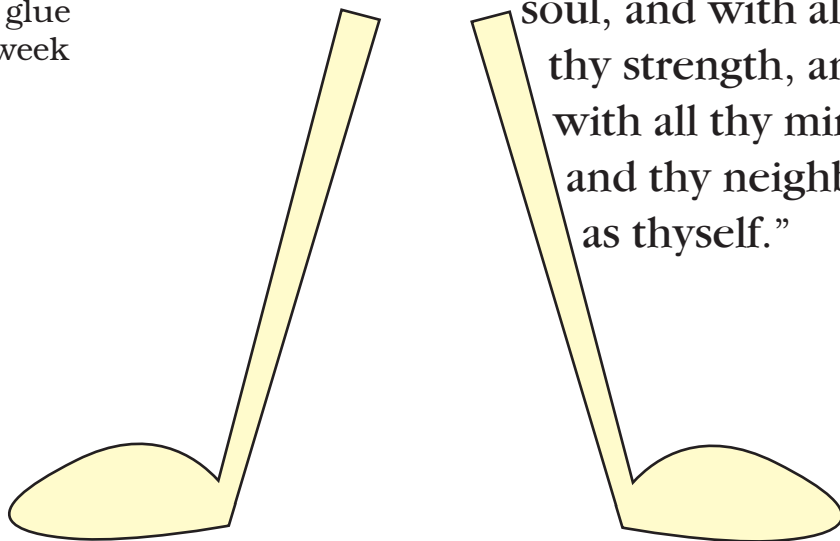

The Throne in Heaven

Revelation 4:1-11

John saw a door open in Heaven and a loud voice telling him to come and see things that would happen. He saw God sitting on the throne with a bright, fiery light shining like colorful gems. He saw a rainbow around the throne that looked to him like emerald.

Worship is to focus attention on God's worth. It is the main thing that happens in Heaven. John saw lightnings and heard thunderings and voices coming out of the throne of God. He saw four angelic beings called beasts, or angelic creatures, near

God's throne. Their words gave glory, honor and thanks to God. The twenty-four elders, special worshipers seated around God's throne, were dressed in white clothes with crowns of gold. The elders fell down before God in worship.

God deserves praise because of who He is. He is the only true and living God. The Bible teaches God is Spirit and must be worshiped in spirit. We can see God by reading the Bible. We see Him by knowing who He is, what He has done and what He can do. God had no beginning. He has no ending.

God deserves praise because of what He has done. God is the Creator of all things that exist. He designed the entire universe and put everything that exists in its place. He put the galaxies and planets in space. He put people, plants and animals on the earth.
